[Old/New Testament](#) - Each day includes a passage from both the Old Testament and New Testament.

[Chronological](#) - Read the Bible in the chronological order in which its stories and events occurred.

[Beginning](#) - Read the Bible from start to finish, from Genesis to Revelation.

[Historical](#) - Read the books of the Bible as they were written historically, according to the estimated date of their writing.

- the New Testament twice through the year
- the Psalms twice through the year
- the Proverbs twice through the year

A:sk for God's help

Y:ield to His will in your life.
